Is It Ok To Have Your Personal Information On Papers And Documents When They Are Being Recycled In A Recycle Centre?

When the contents of the household recycling bin arrives at a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) for sorting the truck empties out everything. All this recycling is then pushed through a mechanical and manual sorting process.

Paper gets separated from the other materials and arranged into bales.

Paper with personal information on it isn't separated out for shredding. Both Repak and the recovery operators recommend shredding or ripping up paper with personal information before placing it in your recycling bin.

Can I Put The Metal Lids Of Jam Jars And Other Glass Jars Into My Recycling Bin?

You can indeed place the steel lids from jam and sauce jars in your household recycling bin. Please just make sure they are clean and dry. You can put other steel items in as well such as food tins, biscuit tins and aerosol cans (just make sure they are empty and the lids are off)
